The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is intended for those 18 & above who are ● Not baptised or ● Baptised Christians from denomina-

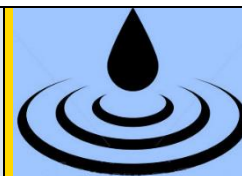

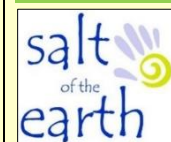
### NATIVITY of ST. JOHN the BAPTIST

In Luke 7:28, Jesus declared John to be the greatest man to have ever lived. He was the last and greatest of the prophets. John's greatest strength was his **focused and faithful commitment to the call of God** on his life. When we come to realize that God has given us a specific purpose for our lives, we can move forward with confidence, fully trusting in God Who called us.



**SAINTS PETER & PAUL:** Peter (an unlettered fisherman) and Paul (scholar of the law) are the two men most responsible

for spreading the Christian message in the early Church through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom. On this great feast, we see that the **call to holiness is addressed to everyone**, and rededicate ourselves to being true witnesses of Christ.
