- 2. Parents must attend the pre-Baptism session conducted by the parish.
- 3. Please note that it is a necessary prerequisite that Godparents must be Catholic and must also attend the pre-Baptism session conducted by the parish where the child is to be baptised.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

You are requesting to have your child baptised. In doing so, you are accepting the responsibility of bringing up your child in the practice of the Catholic Faith.

Therefore it follows that:

- At least one parent (if not both) is baptized and confirmed in the Catholic faith and practising their faith.
- Parents were married in a Catholic Church and have registered with the Registrar of Civil Marriage.
- Godparents must be Catholic i.e. baptised and confirmed in the Catholic faith, practising their faith and should be present at the Baptism Ceremony.
- In the case of a mixed marriage, the Non-Catholic partner must provide a letter of commitment to bring up the child in the Catholic faith.
- Please give your child a Baptismal name that has a relation to the Catholic faith or is otherwise meaningful. A name taken from the Bible, a name derived from that of a Saint or even a close relative. Kindly avoid the names of pop idols or precious gems etc. Remember that the gift of a name signifies the holiest human experience and entry into relationship
- As the first Teachers of your child, you are responsible for the Religious Education of your child by word and example.
- Please ensure that your child of 5 years and above attend Sunday School on an ongoing and regular basis. You are also responsible for imparting Christian values and attitudes as taught by the Catholic Church.
- Following the Sacrament of Baptism, please ensure that your child receives the other Sacraments i.e. the Sacrament of Reconciliation, The Sacrament of First Holy and the Sacrament of Confirmation.
